We're excited to announce that a major refurbishment project is underway at the club – a huge step forward in improving our facilities for players, supporters, and the wider community.

What's Changing?

We're investing close to £250,000 into transforming our clubhouse and surrounding areas. Here's what's coming:

- 🏠 New 21m x 12m marquee – Connected directly to our existing clubhouse, this space will become our new social hub, perfect for post-match gatherings, club events, and celebrations.
- 🍹 Bar extension into the conservatory – The bar will be expanded and linked to the marquee, creating more bar space and improving service during busy matchdays and social events.
- 🍔 New kitchen facility – We're opening our own kitchen, allowing us to serve hot matchday food on Saturdays and Sundays to players, families, and supporters. This will be a key way to enhance the matchday experience and generate extra support for the club.
- 🏊 Upgraded changing rooms – The current clubhouse will be converted into additional changing areas. One room will be designed to section off for our ladies' team or junior players, ensuring privacy and safeguarding during overlaps with men's games.
